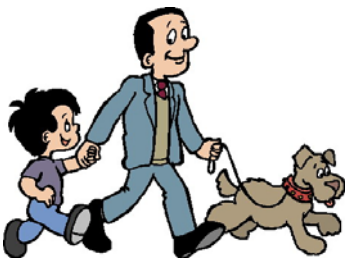

The City of Harlem will soon have a new garbage contractor. Precision Waste Services will be taking over garbage service for Harlem customers beginning in January 2016. Every water customer will receive information from Precision Waste Services detailing their services and pick up days. New containers will be delivered beginning around the second week of December and notices will also be included on each container that will inform you of your scheduled pick up day.
