DOWNTOWN STREET CONVERTED TO ONE-WAY

In 2016, New Street in downtown Harlem became a one-way street. This allowed traffic coming from North Louisville Street to turn onto New Street. However, no traffic is permitted to turn onto North Louisville Street from New Street. The change in traffic pattern has allowed additional on-street parking to New Street. Signs and markings have been installed to alert motorists of the change.
