#### 2018 UTILITY RATES EFFECTIVE 1/1/2018

With the approval of the FYE 12/31/2018 Budget, the following Water/Sewer Rate schedule has been approved and is effective as of 1/1/2018. The rates will be included on the billing that will go out at the end of February.

#### **Utility Rates:**

In-City water and sewer base charge: \$9.00 per REU (Residential Equivalent Unit)
Unincorporated water and sewer base charge: \$18.00 per REU (Residential Equivalent Unit)

\$9.35 per 1,000 gallons

Tier 1—(1-999999999) \$8.00 per 1000 gallons \$8.70 per 1000 gallons

#### Utility Deposit Charges, Set Up Fee, and Administrative Charge:

Residential Accounts: Single Family—\$50.00 deposit Multi-Family—\$50.00 each unit deposit

Non-Residential Accounts: Commercial—\$100.00 deposit Restaurants—\$250.00 deposit

Hotel, Motel—\$25.00 each unit Set Up Fees—\$15.00 per account

Deposits may be applied to account balances or refunded after 18 months of timely payments. Set up fees are non-refundable.

Administrative Fee: \$1.00 per Residential Account \$3.00 per Commercial Account
