GARBAGE SCHEDULE

Coastal Waste will be closed Monday, December 25th for Christmas. Garbage and recycle pickup will be on a one day delay the week of December 25th.

Coastal Waste will be closed for New Year's Day, Monday, January 1st. There will be a one day delay for garbage and recycle service the week of January 1st.

FROM THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT: INSTALLING DRIVEWAYS

Many homeowners eventually decide that their dirt driveway needs to be paved or that they need a second driveway to the back yard. Both can be expensive. In certain cases, there are development rules that need to be checked before beginning. Planning beforehand can give you a long-lived driveway that is safely designed. Guidelines include:

- Outside a historic district, installing a concrete driveway does not need a building permit.
- Connecting to a city street or state highway requires checking with the Public Works department for utility encroachment requirements.
- 3. Installation of a new driveway requires looking at a safety issue about the location
- The city is concerned about how a new driveway will impact stormwater flow.

We would like to ask anyone who is thinking about a new driveway to contact the city to review the process. The turn-around time is small and working together early can prevent problems later.

From the Harlem Museum and Welcome Center:

The Harlem Museum and Welcome Center has a new welcome area set up inside the Columbia Theatre. This welcome spot also includes a 'Kid Station' where kids can come in and draw on some coloring sheets.

We also have the Christmas Festival and Holiday Market coming up on December 9th from 11a.m. - 8p.m. (vendor market from 11a.m. - 5p.m.). Our annual Twilight Parade will begin promptly at 6 p.m. and the tree lighting ceremony will begin once the parade ends. We will have several special guests for the event, including Mickey and Minnie Mouse, and one of our favorite delivery men in a red suit! Voting for the movie is currently on Harlem Happenings on Facebook. The movie will begin after the Tree Lighting Ceremony.

From November 25th until December 13th, we will have a kids craft inside the museum at the Kids Station. Our young locals can drop in and fill out their letter to Santa and place it in the mailbox in front of the Museum. The Women's Club has set the mailbox out on Mr. and Mrs. Claus' behalf!
