MOBILE FOOD TRUCK OPERATIONS

There has been an increase in demand for Mobile Food Vendors in Harlem. Whether you own or manage a business in Harlem, these Mobile Food Vendors need to be permitted before they can operate out of their mobile units. If you are planning a customer appreciation event or any other event at your location where Mobile Food Trucks will be operating, contact Harlem City Hall well in advance so we can get the information you need. Be advised, the owner of the Mobile Food Truck will need to have the permit in hand at least two weeks prior to the event.

From the Harlem Public Safety Department:

HOUSE WATCH

A **house watch request** for a residence can be requested when you are going to be out of town or away from the residence for a period of time. This would include for officers to walk around the premise of the residence, check windows, doors, etc.

A **concentrated patrol** should be requested when the resident will be at home. The officer would ride by the location checking for any activity reported by the requestor. This could be for a residence or a specified area (business, neighborhood, residence, etc.). This would apply to any business wishing extra patrol for suspicious activity or for any problems they may be experiencing. For safety reasons we would not want any officers to check windows, or pull on doors to make sure they are secure if the resident is at home, particularly in late night or early morning hours.

A house watch request application may be found on the cities website, www.harlemga.org. The request should be emailed to our department at pdrecords@harlemga.org, it can be dropped off at the department or called into the CCSO Dispatch Center at 706-541-2800. The requests are shared at both the communications center as well within our department.
