#### FROM THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT: HOME OCCUPATIONS:

The city has long supported business owners. When these businesses are located in a neighborhood, conflicts with neighbors can happen. The city has enacted certain special rules to balance the needs of a small business with the desire of neighbors to be safe, healthy, and enjoy tranquility. We would like to remind everyone of the special requirements for a home occupation:

- 1. All businesses operating in the City of Harlem must obtain an Occupational Tax Certificate.
- 2. There are special regulations of a home occupation operating in a neighborhood.
- 3. By state law, certain inspections and notifications must take place.
- 4. Certain businesses are not allowed and others must obtain special permission to operate.

We would like to ask anyone who is thinking about opening a home business to contact the city to review the process. An occupational tax certificate is sometimes required by a bank for a checking account.
