GARBAGE REMINDER

A reminder that all loose garbage must be put in enclosed bags before placing in your garbage container. The garbage contractor will only pick up garbage that is inside your container as they are not required to pick up items placed on the ground beside your supplied container. In-City customers, please remember that only TWO bulk items such as furniture, appliances, etc. should be put out for pick up each week.

Also, Section 26-26 of the City Code of Ordinances states that refuse containers shall be moved BEHIND THE PROPERTIES within 24 hours after having been serviced and emptied.

Please do your part and help keep Harlem clean!
