| Temporary | Nonresidential uses that are developed properties with vacant lots, units, and/or tenant spaces <br> Number permitted: 1 sign per driveway <br> Maximum display area: 16 square feet <br> Maximum height: 6 feet <br> Time period: 90 days per period, 2 periods per calendar year maximum. |
| Wall | Number permitted: 2 per building on lots occupied by a non-residential use. <br> Display area: $5 \%$ or less of the area of the wall to which they are attached. <br> Projection: 6 inches or less from the surface of the wall to which they are attached. |
| Window | Display area: $25 \%$ or less of the window area. |
