# **Donation Bin Permit Application**

A permit is required to place a donation bin on any commercial, professional, or industrial property in the City. The permit must be renewed annually and expires on December 31<sup>st</sup> of each year. Insurance and screening from the public right of way is required for each bin. More information is on the reverse of this page.

#### Location and Placement

Bins are allowed in all commercial, industrial, and professional districts. Bins shall not be placed in the following manner:

- 1. Projecting onto or over any public roadway or public street
- 2. Resting in whole or in part upon any portion of a public right of way or projecting onto or over the same.
- 3. In any required buffer area.
- 4. Within twenty-five feet of any driveway, fire hydrant, or crosswalk.

Bins shall be placed on a hard, level, and weather resistant surface.

#### <u>Number</u>

No more than one donation bin per parcel or location per entity or person with a total of three allowed per parcel or location.

#### Screening

Screening shall be in a manner to effectively shield the bin from being viewed from the public right of way as determined by Planning & Zoning Department staff on a case by case basis. Vegetation may be included as screening.

#### **Donated Materials**

Donated materials or clothing shall not be placed on or around the exterior of the bin. Violations shall be treated as a public nuisance and be abated within ten business days or face penalties.

#### <u>Bins</u>

Bins may be made of steel, metal or a similar durable product.

Maximum size is 12 feet in length, 6 feet in width, and 6 feet in height.

The name, website, address, and telephone number of the registered person or entity who owns the bin and any other entity who may share in the profit from any clothing or material collected via the bin must be clearly and conspicuously displayed on the exterior.

Bins and screening shall not be used for any advertisement, signage, or other promotional materials other than the display of information provided for in this application.

### Time of Decision by the City of Harlem

The Planning & Zoning Department shall have 30 business days to issue or deny the permit. A notification of issuance or denial shall be mailed or hand delivered to the applicant's address on or before the thirtieth business day. If denied, the notice shall state the reasons for denial.
