



GARBAGE GUIDELINES:

Waste materials must be **INSIDE** the provided Garbage Cart. Any items placed outside the cart will **NOT** be collected.

Collection Day: Carts should be **at the curb by 6:00 AM** on your scheduled collection day.

APPROVED WASTE

- YES** – Non-hazardous municipal solid waste
- YES** – Food scraps and food packing
- YES** – Disposables
- YES** – Clothing
- YES** – Compost
- YES** – Bottles, cans, newspapers & magazines

NOT ACCEPTABLE

- NO** – Yard Waste
- NO** – **Hazardous Materials:** Includes but not limited to: batteries, automotive fluids (fuel, antifreeze, oils), paint, lacquer, stain, thinner, varnish, wood preservatives, and chemicals of any kind (i.e. pool chemicals, pesticides and weed killer)
- NO** – **Empty Hazardous Material Containers**
- NO** – **Electronic Waste:** Includes but not limited to: televisions, computers, monitors, printers, VCRs, cell phones, telephones, radios and microwave ovens
- NO** – **Radioactive Materials**
- NO** – **Biological/Medical Waste**
- NO** – **Liquids or Water-Soluble Solids**
- NO** – **Salt, borax, lye, caustics/acids**
- NO** – **Septic Tank or Chemical Toilet Waste**
- NO** – **Fluorescent Light Tubes and Ballasts**
- NO** – **Automobile Bodies**



GARBAGE GUIDELINES:

NOT ACCEPTABLE

NO - Treated Wood, 4'x4' post/wood, wood that has nails, Canadian Pallets (these are blue in color).

Will accept 2' x 4' wood as long as it less than 4 ft. long; Pallets that are standard size 40" x 48" are acceptable.
